- inequalities in child health and development
- how early childhood education and care can deflect developmental trajectories of disadvantage
- how the built environment impacts child health inequalities
- place-based interventions to assist families facing disadvantage
- other, similar topics

Payment type: Living allowance and stipend top up

Value: \$37,000 AUD per annum (three years), plus \$10,000 AUD top-up
